Moon Watch!

This week pupils in years 4 and 6 have started to explore our solar system as part of different topics in science. The enthusiasm has been overwhelming! Knowing this, I thought I would share with you an excellent resource and an international event happening THIS WEEKEND! If your eyes need a break from the formula one, then why not look to the skies! This weekend is NASA's International Observe The Moon event! The event is huge, and you can register your participation, but, more interestingly, there are **FREE moon maps available** online showing what you should be able to observe through binoculars and telescopes if you look this Saturday night! The maps highlight natural features and **landing sites** so you can see where those 24 humans who have visited our moon actually walked! As our only natural satellite the moon is so important to our planet, and I know your children would love to take a closer look! Inexpensive binoculars that magnify at least x15 will work well enough to see some features and the reflection on the surface will be bright enough to show features even with our city light pollution, so it's an excellent home project!
